**Historical seismology in Europe and the  
making of the European Archive of Historical Earthquake Data**

Since more than twenty years, historical seismology is now a well established branch of seismology making use of historical and seismological methods and provide a wealth of data which are unique for many events of a time window of about 1000 years, in Europe at least. Some examples and case histories from the European area will illustrate the current state-of-the-art of historical seismological investigation. Then, the in progress initiatives for the establishment of a distributed archive of Historical Earthquake Data in Europe, carried out in the frame of the EU NERIES project and the ad-hoc ESC WG, will be presented.
