EDITORIAL COSTS AND STYLE GUIDELINES FOR PUBLICATION OF THE PRESENTED PAPERS

IMPORTANT NOTE:

The presentations, in case of being accepted for the V International Congress on Environmental and Territorial Sustainability, may be published with a previous additive cost, to be published by the following editorials:

- (1) Journal “[Thomson Reuters / Aranzadi](#)” of Spain, within a quality impact of the publisher, first quartile of the SPI (Scholarly Publisher Indicator), and with validity for the six-year research period.
- (2) Journal “[Justicia Ambiental, Territorio y Sostenibilidad](#)”, of the CEDITEX/FISAT Editorial of Perú. [Volume II](#), multidisciplinary.
- (3) Journal “[Monfragüe Resiliente](#)” (ISSN 2340-5457) – this journal focusses its scientific work on the theme of environmental resilience, as a concrete focus on the traditional concept of Sustainability – no publication fee

EDITORIAL COSTS:

The authors who have presented their paper at the V Congress, may publish at the Editorial of their own choice, with the following previous cost/payment:

Journal “Thomson Reuters / Aranzadi” of Spain	
Editorial rights	The publication, in case of being accepted, has an additional cost of 300€. The maximum extension for each published paper, as a book chapter, are 12 pages. Graphs are only accepted in high quality.
Additional payments	Each additional page has a cost of 20 euros.
¿What is included in the price?	One printed and one digital version will be handed to the author. If you want the printed version to be send to a different country than Spain, an additional cost must be paid, apart from the cost/payment of the post office. (The author must inform about the additional sending costs to their country). The digital version will be handed in with an eBook code with which the publication can be saved in PDF format.

Journal “Justicia Ambiental, Territorio y Sostenibilidad” of Perú	
Editorial rights	The publication, in case of being accepted, has a cost of 175€. The maximum extension for each published paper, as a book chapter, are 20 pages. Graphs are only accepted in high quality.
Additional payments	Each additional page has a cost of 10€.
¿What is included in the price?	One printed and one digital version will be handed to the author. If you want the printed version to be send to a different country than Peru, an additional cost must be paid, apart from the cost/payment of the post office. (The author must inform about the additional sending costs to their country). The digital version will be handed in with an eBook code with which the publication can be saved in PDF format.

STYLE GUIDELINES : JOURNAL "THOMSON REUTERS / ARANZADI" SPAIN

IMPORTANT NOTE :

The extent of the presented papers to the congress must not exceed 12 pages. All additional pages will have an extra cost.

general information:

It is important to adjust the explained regulations below to be able to publish any type of contribution. The papers which do not adjust these regulations will be send back to the author.

Manuscript: The manuscripts will be sent for their review in .doc format and alternatively *.docx. No papers will be accepted in other text formats. When a manuscript is sent for its first review, tables, images, must be incorporated at their corresponding place within the text and the appendixes must be placed after the references in consecutive order. Manuscripts send for review must have all page numbers to facilitate the evaluation process.

Th structure that the send contributions must have will be detailed below.

Title: The title must be figured in bold. It must be indicated in English and Spanish in separated lines.

Example: **El desarrollo resiliente y el comercio internacional**

The resilient development and international trade

Abstract: Within the abstract must figure the purpose of the article, a synthesis of the used methodology and the most relevant results obtained with its implications. The abstract must have a maximum extending of 250 words, including, within the first line, the title of the article. It is a must to present an abstract in English, apart from one in Spanish, or in its case Portuguese or French. Send contributions to the section of Notes and Book reviews are exempted from the abstract. Please minimize the use of abbreviations and do not cite references within the body of the abstract.

Key words: five to seven key words will be indicated in English and Spanish. Key words must not repeat words found within the title. They must be alphabetical ordered and separated among them by a comma. Key words of the sent contributions to the section of notes and book reviews are exempted.

Definition of the sheet: Margins: top, bottom, right and left: 2,5 cm. general page format: A4

Text: The typography of the title, must be Arial and the size 14 pt. The name of the author or authors and their academic connection must be of size 12 pt. as the main text and the titles of the headings. Long citations must have size 11 pt., and the footnotes 10 pt.

Author information: This section must include any relevant information about the author/s, which helps the readers to understand and interpret the article and point of view of the author. Consequentially, the name and surname of the author, his academic background and his institutional affiliation must be included. The names of the authors must be indicated in bold and separated lines in this order: 1) Name, 2) Surname(s).

The institutional affiliation will be indicated next to the name of the author, between bracket, next to the complete home address of each author. One paragraph will be used for each affiliation.

Example:

Maribel Capra (Department of Territorial Sciences, Faculty of Humanities, Universidad Nacional de La Plata, 1900 La Plata, Buenos Aires, Argentina).

Main text: Research papers will typically contain next sections: Introduction, Material and methods, results, discussion, conclusions. The rest of the contributions won't normally require sections. The authors can create sections according to the order within each section.

They must contain a line spacing 1.5. One blank space between each paragraph and start of a not tabulated paragraph. The references to figures and tables must be marked in bold and started with a capital letter. If they are cited, you must explicitly use figure X or table X, otherwise it will be cited between brackets and in case of the figures abbreviated (Fig. X).

Symbols, abbreviations and acronyms must be defined the first time they are used. Measurement units must be used according to the international system of units.

Numbers must be represented in the following way: Units of thousand without space (e.g. 3000 m); tens of thousands and forward must be separated every three positions by a space (e.g. 27 000 kg, 3 276 000 ha). Decimal values must be limited to a maximum of 3 decimal positions and indicated with a point instead of a comma. (e.g. 0.426 mm).

1.- Paragraph titles will be indicated with decimal numbering, as in the following example:

1. Introduction
- 1.1. Digital Literature
- 1.1.1. Narrative published in blogs

The normal: on both sides justified with a first line separation (1,25 cm).

Quotations and footnotes: quotations must appear within justified paragraphs, without putting them between commas. If, within the quotation, parts of the text are omitted, this will be marked using three points between square brackets: [...]. Footnotes must be justified and in a superscript style.

Any acknowledgement or references made to projects, foundations, etc. will be indicated in a footnote in name of the author.

Bibliographic references: Within the text, references will be quoted according to the last name of the author/s, and year of the publication in brackets. Every bibliographic quotation that is being used in the text must be found within the list of references according to the defined criteria below. In the same way, there can't be any bibliographic references within the list of references that haven't been quoted within the text.

Within the list of references, the papers will be quoted in alphabetic order of the first author. In case there are more references with the same first author, these will be quoted in alphabetic order by the second author and so forth. When it is necessary to cite more references of the same author/s they

To quote different papers within the section of reference, the next guidelines must be followed. In all cases type Arial 10 will be used.

In case of articles of serial publications, complete last names of all the authors must be written in lower case, followed by the initials of their names; year of publication; title of the paper; title of the journal in italics; the volumen and pages.

In case of books complete last names of all authors must be written in lower case, followed by the initials of their names; year of publication, title of the book in italics, editorial; city and country of publication.

In case of book chapters, last names of all authors must be written in lower case, followed dby the initials of their names; year of publication; title of the chapter; names of the editors of the book in which it has been published (following the same instructuions as for the rest of authors); title of the book in italics; rango of pages of the chapter; editorial; city and country of publication.

If the number of authors of a publication exceeds 6, et al. can be used to refer to the other authors, from the tenth forward.

In case of a thesis or report complete names of all the authors must be written in low case, followed by the initials of their names; year of publication; title of the project in italics; editing institution and country of publication.

In case of a legislation the next format must be followed: jurisdiction; year; title of the normative, name of publication in italics, volume, date of publication, page rank.

For papers that are in process of publishing, "in press" will be used to replace the date of publication within the quotation and within the text and list of bibliographic references. Papers which are "being reviewed" or unpublished must be quoted as "unpublished data" or "personal communication" and their corresponding reference will not be included within the list of references. As far as possible it will be advised not to quote abstracts of congresses or writing reports which are not available on the internet.

Web references: To specify dates of a web page, last names must be figured and a complete name, year and between brackets the title of the web. <URL>. (date of access).

Example: Millán, José Antonio. Jamillan. <<http://www.jamillan.com>> (31-8-2011).

References of articles within digital journals: Last names and complete names must be figured between brackets. The title of the article or section must go between commas. The name of the journal will be given, number between brackets, electronic address and date of access, as indicated within the example..
