The doctoral school is addressed to PhD / doctoral students, advanced master-by-research students and local professors working at universities on topics related to the school theme. The objective is to stimulate collaboration between young researchers in the area of operations management, logistics and supply chain management in general. Participants will have the opportunity to interact with experienced researchers and professors by sharing the findings of their researches and participating in mini-courses, tutorials and plenary conferences.
