

Peopling the Past: Reflecting on Prehistoric Europe

Call for Papers: early career researchers

The Prehistoric Society in collaboration with the Department of Archaeology, University of Cambridge, invite early career researchers to submit a paper proposal for the Europa conference 2023.

Prof Marie Louise Stig Sørensen, McDonald Institute for Archaeological Research, University of Cambridge, will be honoured with the Europa prize for her contribution to European prehistory. The conference will look at issues explored in Professor Stig Sørensen's research on the Bronze Age in Scandinavia, Central Europe and England, investigating several aspects of life and death in Bronze Age communities. Her research also includes a focus on gender studies in prehistory and cultural heritage preservation.

Conference presentations will take place over two days (2nd-3rd June), with the first day devoted to early career researchers. Along with two full days of lectures, the conference will also include a half-day field trip to the Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology and Wandlebury hill fort on Sunday 4th June.
